

The Veterans History Project (VHP) collects and preserves memorials honoring American war veterans and civilian workers who supported them. The project relies on volunteers across America to collect veterans' stories on behalf of the Library of Congress which are then made available to researchers and the general public, both at the actual Library in Washington and online at the VHP website.

The project was created in 2000. Congress unanimously authorized legislation creating the VHP and President Clinton signed the bill into law on October 27, 2000.
