

SAN ANTONIO, TEXAS – San Antonio Congressman Charlie Gonzalez announced the awarding of a \$1,742,609 Federal Highway Administration grant that will extend 36th

Street SW through the center of Port San Antonio. This funding will greatly increase Port San Antonio's capacity as a trade hub for the region. Congressman Charlie Gonzalez issued the following statement regarding the grant for the new San Antonio trade corridor:

“This funding will increase San Antonio's economic production, its manufacturing capacity, and it will ultimately result in a tremendous growth in local jobs. This award represents the people of San Antonio's willingness to come together in order to reinvest in our community and create jobs. Once again, San Antonio has shown itself to be an example of how communities can overcome economic hardships through a commitment to collaboration.
